

Complementary ADA Paratransit Service for Out-of-Town Visitors

If you are visiting Lake County, and have been determined eligible by another transit or public agency, then Laketran will honor that eligibility while you are here.

- 1. Before you arrive or before you need to use ADA complementary paratransit service, you need to provide proof of your eligibility from your "home" agency.
 - a. Contact your local certifying agency. Ask them to notify the Laketran Customer Outreach Specialist of your ADA eligibility OR
 - b. Provide documentation to the Laketran Customer Outreach Specialist of your eligibility directly.
- 2. A visitor can present, if the individual's disability is not readily apparent, proof of disability and proof of visitor status.
 - a. Proof of disability can be a letter from a doctor or rehabilitation professional.
 - b. Proof of visitor status can be a proof of residence somewhere else that is not within Laketran's jurisdiction.
- 3. You will be able to use Laketran's Paratransit service for 30 days during a calendar year.
- 4. If you need service beyond 30 days, you will need to apply for local ADA certification.

If you are a resident of Lake County and are traveling:

- 1. Contact the Laketran Customer Outreach Specialist for help in notifying your destination city of your ADA certification.
- 2. The length of time you are allowed to use the service will be determined by their local policy.
